The Boston Foundation offers four investment pools to Donor Advised Funds. These four pools allow donors to customize their asset allocation by investing among these pools. The Balanced Plus Pool asset mix is expected to produce the highest long-term investment return. Accordingly, the Boston Foundation invests the majority of its endowment assets in the Balanced Plus Pool.

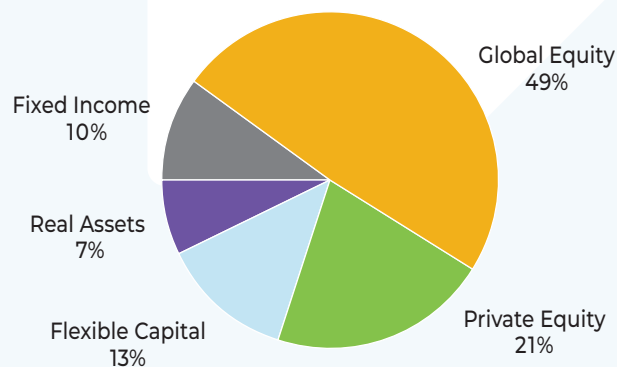

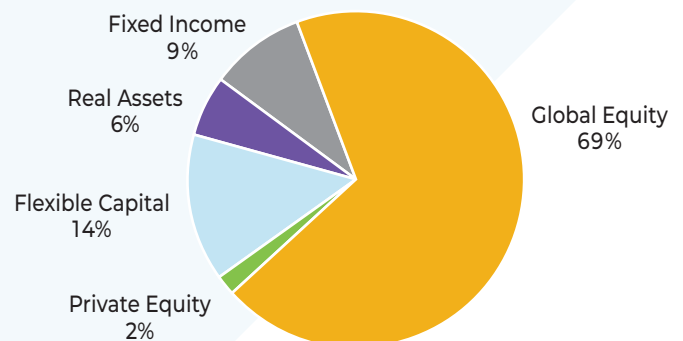

MISSION FIRST POOL OVERVIEW

The Mission First Pool will make investments that advance The Boston Foundation's mission of building a better Boston by helping narrow some of the region's greatest disparities. The Pool focuses on capital preservation with modest financial returns and is currently invested primarily in the Vanguard Money Market Fund and Treasury bills. The first mission-related investment was recently made with the completion of a \$2 million loan to Massachusetts Housing Partnership (MHP) to support low-income housing development and preservation in Greater Boston.
