What is it?

- Dedicated excise tax on cigarettes only
- 30 cents per pack (1.5 mils per cigarette)
- Applies to all of Cuyahoga County
- Generates \$15-17 million annually
- Chartered in ORC3381





CAC grants encourage connections between arts and cultural organizations and the community.

County-Wide Impact

In 2014, Cuyahoga Arts & Culture funded 196 organizations based in Cuyahoga County. Those organizations offered programs in nearly every community in the county – helping to ensure that all residents have access to arts and culture close to home. In 2014, these organizations offered activities in more than 2,500 unique locations in Cuyahoga County – including schools, fibraries, senior centers, theoters, parks, hospitals and neighborhood streets.








What does it take?
