BOSTON IS BEHIND ON ITS CLIMATE GOALS

Net Zero Emissions

Boston is on track to <u>miss its 2030 community emissions</u> <u>target</u> by approximately 5 years due a collective inability to implement big changes over the past decade.

Increase Social Equity

<u>An inequitable transition looms</u> due to a legacy of past harm and a lack of a comprehensive strategy for addressing it.

Climate Resilience

Current governance structures and funding levels <u>are failing to meet</u> the growing resilience need.




